- --Place on a future agenda the continuing discussion of clarifying responsibilities, town and library, for the upkeep of the library building.

- --The idea was raised for future discussion of adding space in the library to house the Brattleboro Historical Society --Could a third floor be added to be used for many purposes?
  - --Request has been made for a more readable clock above the circulation desk.
  - --Yellow chairs and table seem to be well liked by patrons.
  - --Outside sidewalk in front of building needs leveling.
