- Children's room windows replacement under way soon (town)
- Paint hallways
- · Strip wallpaper and paint in upstairs entry hallway
 - · Requires removing Hunt bas-relief
 - New downstairs location for this piece
 - Add new artwork to upstairs entry?
- New furniture
 - In time to avoid moving old, non-cleanable furniture back in
- BROOKS MEMORIAL LIBRARY sign on outside of building
 - · Starr to speak with town planner
- Standardize and improve indoor signage
 - · To harmonize with new outdoor sign?
- Staff Room
 - New flooring
 - New seating
- · Renovate existing garden
 - · Allow for access and seating
 - · Re-set or move pillars and fence
- Add additional single study spaces and small-group meeting spaces
 - Fine arts storage, archival storage underutilized compared to quiet study room

 - Consider terracing the hillside
- Add third floor to building
 - $\circ~$ The building was designed for this -- determine if it is still true
 - Shift children's and teen rooms to new top floor -- currently undersized based on circulation
 - Uses for extra space:
 - Cafe
 - Small/large meeting areas
 - Auditorium
 - Ability to allow separate access after library hours a plus
- Addition to 2nd floor at back
 - More modest project than third floor; would still provide some needed space
